PURE GABBY (Hula Records 567) - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - recorded in 1961 and issued in 1978

HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY, VOLUME 1-WITH GABBY PAHINUI (Waikiki Records 319) – Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - 1960

HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY, VOLUME 2-WITH GABBY PAHINUI (Waikiki Records 320 – with the *same cover* as VOLUME 1) – Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble (and with the *same cover* as VOLUME 1) - 1960

THE BEST OF HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY WITH GABBY PAHINUI (Waikiki Records 340) – Vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble recordings - recordings approximately from the late 1950s or the early 1960s

THE HISTORY OF HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY GUITAR-VINTAGE HAWAIIAN TREASURES, VOLUME 7 (Hana Ola Records 24000) - Compilation including Gabby's 5 earliest recordings from the 1940s - two versions of *Hi`ilawe* originally issued on Bell Records and Aloha Records, and three other tracks from Bell Records - *Hula Medley*, *Key Kohalu*, and *Wai O Ke Aniani*. It also has 15 other reissued late 1940s and early 1950s tracks by 8 other Slack Key guitarists. - *Also see* Various Artists, section 46, #1.

VOLUME 2) – Instrumentals – Gabby is featured playing Slack Key guitar on the songs *Nanea Ko Maka I Ka Le`ale`a* and *Kahuli Aku* (two songs, *Kananaka* and *Ia `Oe E Ka La*, actually feature **Peter Moon** on Slack Key guitar, with Gabby Pahinui on steel guitar) – 1969 – *Also see Peter Moon*, section 20.

EVENING IN THE ISLANDS (Hula Records 509) - Especially the song *Pearly Shells* – 1964 *

IN HAWAI`I THE STORY STARTS (Waikiki Records 334 - out-of-print) - Especially the songs *Lei E, Meleana E,* and *Keawaiki* – has tracks from the late 1950s or the early 1960s *

1e. Gabby Pahinui with Atta Isaacs:

TWO SLACK KEY GUITARS [A LIVIN' A ON EASY] (Tradewinds Records 1124) - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble – (the song titled *March Medley* is actually the track *Ka Ua Noe*, which is a classic pure duet). The reissued CD also contains four instrumental bonus tracks from Atta Isaacs' out-of-print album ATTA: *Mele Li`i, Kokohi -Moani Ke`ala, Na Molokama,* and *Sweet Lei Lehua* – 1969

Four tracks from this album also appear on the reissue THE LEGENDARY ATTA ISAACS–INNOVATIVE HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY GUITAR MASTER (Hana Ola Records HOCD 96000).

----Atta also appears with Gabby on the 5 albums of **The Gabby Pahinui Hawaiian Band** (see 1c above)

MELVEEN WITH THE BEST OF SLACK KEY (Lehua Records 7046) - Vocals by **Melveen Leed**, with backup Slack Key guitar by **Gabby Pahinui** on three songs: *Pua Alani*, *Ka Manu*, and *Ka I'iwi Polena*. This album also features tracks with **Atta Isaacs**, **Sonny Chillingworth**, and **Led Kaapana** - 1980 - *Also see Melveen Leed* under Various Artists, section 46, #3.

SONNY SOLO (Dancing Cat 38005) - Guitar solos and vocals accompanied by solo guitar - 1994

ENDLESSLY (Dancing Cat 38027) - Guitar solos and vocals accompanied by solo guitar - 1999

WAIMEA COWBOY (Lehua SLCD 2003) - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - originally issued on Makaha Records in 1964

SONNY CHILLINGWORTH (Lehua Records 2014 - out-of-print) - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - 1965 *

KA `AINA] O HAWAI`I (Lehua Records 2040 - out-of-print) - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - 1966 *

SONNY (Poki Records 9025 - out-of-print) - Mainly vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble - 1977 *

HAWAI`I ALOHA: ECHOES OF OLD HAWAI`I (Waikiki Records 107 - out-of-print)- A compilation album with two songs by Sonny, *Slack Key Medley (Moana Chimes/Pa`ahana)* and *Whee Ha Swing (Slack Key II)* - these two songs are originally from the out-of-print instrumental 45-rpm record: *Moana/Pa`ahana Chimes* (Waikiki Records 570) and *Whee Ha Swing* (Waikiki Records 571) - these two songs were recorded around 1957 *

- THE OLD WAY (Tradewinds Records 1128 - Reissued with all of Leonard's other early tracks on CD on Hana Ola Records HOCD 55000, with the title THE LEGENDARY LEONARD KWAN-SLACK KEY MASTER-THE COMPLETE EARLY RECORDINGS) – Instrumentals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble – originally issued in 1975

- NANAKULI'S RAYMOND KANE (Tradewinds Records 1130 - Reissued with all of Ray's other early tracks on CD on Hana Ola Records HOCD 52000, with the title THE LEGENDARY RAY KANE-OLD STYLE SLACK KEY-THE COMPLETE EARLY RECORDINGS) - Instrumentals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble – originally issued in 1975
- HAWAIIAN SUNSET MUSIC, VOL. 1 (Hula Records 604) - Slack Key instrumentals, also featuring Slack Key guitarist **Michael Lowe** – 1998
- *Also see **Leonard Kwan & Raymond Kane**, section 5.*
- *One more solo guitar release is planned by Dancing Cat Productions.*

5. Leonard Kwan & Raymond Kane (separate tracks for both guitarists):

SLACK KEY (often called the "Black & White Album") (Tradewinds Records 107)

- the **Leonard Kwan** tracks are reissued with all of his other early tracks on CD on Hana Ola Records (HOCD 55000), with the title LEONARD KWAN–SLACK KEY MASTER–THE COMPLETE EARLY RECORDINGS. The original album contains seven songs by **Leonard Kwan**: *Medley:Aia Hiki Mai/Koni Au/Palisa, Hawaiian Love, 'Opihi Moemoe, Yellow Ginger Lei, Nahenahe, Kaneohe-Mama E, and Manini* - Instrumentals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble - these tracks were all recorded in the late 1950s or early 1960s;

- the **Raymond Kane** tracks are reissued with all of his other early tracks on CD on Hana Ola Records (HOCD 52000), with the title THE LEGENDARY RAY KANE-OLD STYLE SLACK KEY-THE COMPLETE EARLY RECORDINGS. The original album also has six songs by **Ray Kane**: *Kila Kila Haleakala, Willy's Tune, Meleana E* (which is actually *Auwe*), *Auwe* (which is actually *Meleana E*), *Punahela*, and *Wa`ahila* – Instrumentals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble – these tracks were all recorded in the late 1950s or early 1960s

TWO SLACK KEY GUITARS [A LIVIN' ON A EASY] (Tradewinds Records 1124)

- With **Gabby Pahinui** The song *March Medley* is actually called *Ka Ua Noe* and is a classic pure duet. The CD also contains four bonus tracks from the album ATTA (reissued as THE LEGENDARY ATTA ISAACS–INNOVATIVE HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY GUITAR MASTER (Hana Ola Records HOCD 96000): *Mele Li`i, Kokohi -Moani Ke`ala, Na Molokama, and Sweet Lei Lehua* - Instrumentals and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and ensemble – 1969 - Also see **Gabby Pahinui**, section 1e.

ATTA [often called "the Orange Album"] (Tradewinds Records 1126 This album has been reissued as THE LEGENDARY ATTA ISAACS– INNOVATIVE HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY GUITAR MASTER (Hana Ola Records HOCD 96000); and with four tracks from the album TWO SLACK KEY GUITARS: *Waltz Medley: Uluhua Wale Au / Pulupe / Sweet Lei Mamo, Noho Au A Kupa, Keali`i's Mele, and Ka Ua Noe (The Misty Rain)* - Instrumentals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble – recorded in 1971; and with two tracks from album THE NEW HAWAIIAN BAND (Hana Ola Classic Collector Series, Volume 7 HOCD 12000 - formerly released on Trim Records in 1975) – Atta's Slack Key guitar is featured on the songs *Maikai Makani/Kui Au* and *Green Rose Hula*.

THE MAILE SERENADERS—HAWAI`I'S FAVORITE SLACK KEY & STEEL GUITAR, VOLUME 1 (Hula Records 517 - this album was formerly titled KANI KA PILA! VOL. 1) – Especially on the songs *'Alekoki, He'eia, Hi`ilawe, Hanohano Hanalei, Kona Hema, Kona Kai`Opua, Moku Kai Kahi, Nani Ko`olau,`Ula Noweo , and`Ulile E* - (the songs *Kona Kai`Opua* and *Nani Ko`olau* also appear on Gabby Pahinui's "Best Of" recording, KA MAKANA A PAHINUI {THE GIFT OF PAHINUI} on Hula Records 578, even though this recording features **Atta Isaacs** on Slack Key with **Eddie Kamae & The Sons of Hawai'i,** although sometimes **Gabby Pahinui** is erroneously credited) – 1966

THIS IS EDDIE KAMAE AND THE SONS OF HAWAI'I (Hula Records 513 - out-of-print) - Especially on the songs *Beautiful Ke Ala* and *Ko Hanu Ka`u E Li`a Nei* – 1965 *

MARCELLA KALUA—GIRL FROM PAPA KOLEA (Mahalo Records 4012 - out-of-print) - Slack Key backup by **Atta Isaacs,** with **Eddie Kamae & The Sons of Hawai`i** – Especially on the song *Kaho'olawe* - around 1967 *

MELVEEN WITH THE BEST OF SLACK KEY (Lehua Records 7046) - **Atta Isaacs** is featured three songs: *Pauoa Liko Ka Lehua*, *Nanea Kou Maka*, and *Paliakamoa* - This album also features tracks with **Gabby Pahinui**, **Sonny Chillingworth**, and **Led Kaapana** – 1980 - *Also see Melveen Leed* under Various Artists, section 46, #3.

THREE `UKULELES (Waikiki Records 125 – out-of-print) – with John Lukela] - Especially on the song *Slack Key Medley: Maleka's Lullaby/Na Puanani O Hawai'i/Ku'u Ipo Ku'u Pua Aloha/Honolulu Town* – 1962 *

THE NEW HAWAIIAN BAND (Hana Ola Classic Collector Series, Volume 7 HOCD 12000 - formerly released on Trim Records 1975) - **Atta Isaacs'** Slack Key guitar is featured on the songs *Maikai Makani/Kui Au (aka Maika'i Ka Makani 'O Kohala/ Moani Ke Ala)*, *Green Rose Hula*, *Haole Hula*, and *Kekau'pu* – recorded in 1971 and originally released in 1975

HAUOLI (Sounds of Hawaii 5026 - out-of-print) – Especially on the songs *Lahainaluna* and *Akaka Falls* - mid 1960s

WAINANI KANEALII–SONGS OF THE PACIFIC (Lehua Records 5021 – out-of-print) – Especially on the songs *Kuhio Bay*, *Nani Kaua'i*, and *Pu'u O Hulu (Kauli 'Ili)* – 1960s

BILL KAIWA SINGS AT MAUNALAHILAHI! (Hula Records 519 - out-of-print) - with **Eddie Kamae & The Sons of Hawai'i** – Especially on the songs *Ko Leo*, *Lili'ilehua I Mana*, *'Ike 'Ia I Pelekani*, and *Wahine Helela* – 1960s

CHARLES K.L. DAVIS AT HOME (Hula Records 532 - out-of-print) – Especially on the songs *Paoakalani*, *'Ekolu Mea Nui*, *Mahina Malamalama*, and *Malama 'Ia Me 'Oe* – 1960s

STEEL GUITAR HAWAIIAN STYLE (Lehua Records 7023) – with **Jerry Byrd** - – Especially on the songs *Kawahikukupalani*, *Pa'au'au Waltz*, *Jesu Meke Kanaka Wai Wai*, *Maui Chimes*, *How D'ya Do*, *Hilo March*, *Hanalei Moon*, and *Kalima Waltz*. – 1976

15 HAWAIIAN FAVORITES (Poki Records 9002 - out-of-print) – with Poki San – Especially on the songs *Ka Makani Kaili Aloha*, *Kaimana Hila/Waikapu Medley*, and *Kanaka Wai Wai*. [This album was also issued with the title INSTRUMENTAL HAWAIIAN FAVORITES – POKI SAN & FRIENDS] – 1974 *

ALVIN KALEOLANI ISAACS & SONS (Lilinoe Records 101 – out-of-print) – with Alvin, Barney, and Norman Isaacs - Especially the song *Ke Kumuhana Nui* – 1978 *

7. Led Kaapana:

BLACK SAND (Dancing Cat 38015) - Guitar solos, and an autoharp solo, as well as a duet with Slack Key guitarist **Leonard Kwan** - 2000

LED LIVE—SOLO (Dancing Cat 38008) - Guitar solos and vocals accompanied by solo guitar - 1994

LIMA WELA! (Leahi Records 2001 – reissued on Shaka Records SCD 3003) - Instrumentals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble – originally issued in 1983

SIMPLY SLACK KEY (Paradise Records 970) - Instrumentals with acoustic and electric guitar, both played by Led - 1988 *

KIHO'ALU-HAWAIIAN SLACK KEY GUITAR (Rhythm And Roots Records IT-0307) – Instrumentals on solo guitar and with ensemble, and three 'ukulele pieces - 2005

GRANDMASTER SLACK KEY GUITAR (Rhythm And Roots Records RR-0309) – instrumentals and vocals with Slack Key guitar and ensemble - 2006

FORCE OF NATURE (live duet album with Mike Kaawa) - 2008

THE LEGEND – (Rhythm And Roots Records RR-0318) – instrumentals on solo guitar, and vocals accompanied by Slack Key guitar and 'ukelele - 2010

(Dancing Cat 38031) – Pure instrumental duets with **Bob Brozman** on acoustic steel guitar - 1997

WALTZ OF THE WIND (Dancing Cat 38016) – Led plays Slack Key guitar and 'ukulele in ensembles with Mainland Country artists Dirk Powell, Jerry Douglas, Sonny Landreth, Alison Krauss, Ricky Skaggs, and others, as well as two pure duets with Bob Brozman, and pieces with other musicians – 1998
